New Zealand Climate-related Disclosure requirements

Insurance Australia Group Limited (IAG) is a climate reporting entity for the purposes of New Zealand's climate-related disclosure requirements under the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013 (NZ) (FMCA) as a large listed issuer with debt securities quoted on the NZX Debt Market operated by NZX Limited.

IAG gives notice that it is relying on the exemptions in clauses 8 and 10 of the Financial Markets Conduct (Climate-related Disclosures for Foreign Listed Issuers) Exemption Notice 2024 (NZ) in respect of the financial year ended 30 June 2025. The effect of relying on the exemptions is that for the financial year ended 30 June 2025, IAG is not required to prepare and lodge a group climate statement in New Zealand under Part 7A of the FMCA in respect of that accounting period for both its New Zealand and other businesses.

IAG has however voluntarily prepared its own Group Climate-related Disclosure for the most recent financial year, which is included in its 2025 Annual Report. A copy of IAG's 2025 Annual Report can be accessed at www.iag.com.au.
